

"Martin Balleer studied mathematics, economics and law at the University of Hamburg from 1960 to 1965 and earned his doctorate's degree in mathematics at the University of Zurich, Switzerland, in 1968. From 1975 to 2002, he was a member of the board at Gothaer Insurance Group with focus on life insurance incl. chief actuary (main focus), IT and business processes, controlling, accounting, marketing & sales – with changing responsibilities. He was a member of the presidential board of the German Association of Insurers (GDV) and member of the Advisory Board of the German Federal Financial Supervisory Authority (BaFin) from 1997 to 2007. Parallel - from 1995 to 2003 - Martin Balleer was president of the German Actuarial Association (DAV) and participated in several leading functions of the International Actuary Association (IAA). He is a honorary member of the German, British and Swiss actuarial association. In 2003, Martin Balleer founded the European Actuarial Academy GmbH (EAA) in order to support the knowledge transfer to the emerging countries in central, east and south-east Europe. Actually he is a member of the strategic board of EAA. He is active in supporting many countries of this region, i.e. Russia, Serbia, Albania and especially Ukraine, where he takes part in advising the insurance supervision within EU-projects. Since 1995 Martin Balleer offers lectures and seminars in insurance techniques, risk management and insurance law at Göttingen university as an Honorary Professor"
